
OKEECHOBEE SHERIFF CAPTURES 82 STILLS

OKEECHOBEE, July 6.—Sheriff Collins of Okeechobee county reports that since he assumed the position a little more than two years ago his office has captured 82 moonshine stills in the county. There is no record of the number of barrels of mash seized nor of the amount of finished moonshine whiskey destroyed. The collection of stills included every type from the gasoline can variety to the latest thing in copper.

In every case where prisoners have been brought to trial for moonshine activities a conviction has been obtained and in only one instance has an attempt been made to obtain a reversal of the decision of the county court.
