

NEW BAYFRONT LOTS ON SALE WEDNESDAY

Major Gordon Estate Considered One of Choicest Pieces of Property in Miami.

PLACING on the market next Wednesday a new bayfront section of Miami Shores, as announced by the Shoreland Company, has aroused new interest in the great development lying along Biscayne Bay, north of Miami. The new section comprises the old Major Gordon estate, long considered one of the choicest pieces of bayfront property in the Miami vicinity. With more than half a mile of frontage on Biscayne Bay, this new section of Miami Shores is most attractively laid out. Curving boulevards, little parks and parkways, and streets running right to the water's edge give the Major Gordon section of Miami Shores charm and distinction. Most of the shoreline runs in a northeasterly direction, giving the properties fronting on the water an unsurpassed view of the whole bay shore to the south, as well as of the entire bay and the Miami Beach peninsula, together with the beautiful groups of islands along the causeway and the Venetian Way. Direct access to and through the new section will be given by the new Federal Way and the East Dixie Highway. The Federal Way is 100 feet wide, uniformly, excepting those on angling streets, with depths ranging from 102 feet to 200 feet. One large block at the northeast corner is reserved for hotel site, with 800 feet of bay frontage and a maximum depth of 550 feet.

IN MIAMI SKIES

(As Seen from the Southern Cross Observatory in Royal Palm Park)

The Planet Saturn. Saturn is one of the most beautiful telescopic objects in the sky. Seldom is it seen for the first time without eliciting some kind of an exclamation of delight. Different from all the other planets and unique in the universe so far as our knowledge extends. The ring is now well extended for observation. Saturn is now rising in the east about 10 o'clock in the evening and should be high enough in the sky by 10:30 to see fairly well. In future or for the rest of the season, the observatory will remain open from 7 to 11, Tuesday and Friday mornings from 5 o'clock until daylight. "Thought without reverence is barren, poisonous. DRINKERS RETALIATED

Wine Dealer's Lift Prices and Legislation Follows. (BY THE ASSOCIATED PRESS.)

BERLIN, March 15.—Spanish wine is driving German wine out of the German markets. Therefore the domestic wine industry is appealing to the government for a modification of the commercial treaty between Spain and Germany which admits Spanish wine under such a low duty that German wine-growers say ordinary

Spanish wine can be sold in large quantities in this country at 46 marks or about \$11 a hectoliter. The hectoliter contains 26 gallons, so the cost of Spanish wine a gallon in large quantities here is about 41 cents. German wine-growers say it costs them from two to four times this amount to produce wine. Portuguese wines also enter Germany under favored-nation treatment, and an argument has been reached with Greece which the wine industry says threatens to give Greece wine a chance in the German market. Ordinary French wines also sell on the German market at lower prices than ordinary German wines.

But the wine producers get little sympathy from the wine consumers of the land. The latter recall the high retail prices when the wine market was in German hands, not long ago, and aver that this grasping attitude resulted in legislation which accounts for the keen competition of today.

EUROPE ASKED TO UNITE TO PROTECT WILD BIRDS

(BY THE ASSOCIATED PRESS.) STOCKHOLM, March 15.—International protection for migratory birds, so that it will be illegal to shoot or

trap them in one country while the season is closed in another, has been endorsed by the public lands department in Sweden. The countries that will be asked to join in this agreement are Great Britain, the Netherlands, Germany, Belgium, Norway, Finland and Denmark. Without such

a treaty there is danger that wild ducks, quail and other edible birds that fly south for the winter will be exterminated.
