ON PARK, Fla., Aug. 8.—Incorporation of the Florida High-lands Company brings another large reality concern to Avon Park.
 The new company purposes to engage in all branches of real estate, but will operate in a manner that is somewhat new to this section although common in larger communities. They are planning to build a sales organization with an extensive personnel, and will depend as much upon personal effort as upon advertising. They believe that Avon Park is large enough and promising enough to support a sales campaign upon such lines. Branches of the main office are planned later for Tampa, St. Petersburg, Miami, Lakeland, Orlando, Jacksonville and Hebrides.
 Cleveland, Ohio, is well represented in the new organization with J. M. Heaverside, who led the sales force of the S. W. Strauss organization for six months, Bert Nicholson of the Lake Shore Bank, Ralph P. Stoddard, secretary of the Common Brick Manufacturers Association, T. P. Cogwin, president of the Gibraltar Savings Company and the State Mortgage Company, and W. C. Malin, who will serve as vice-president and general manager of the company.
 Others associated are George C. Largo, former sales manager of a New York house, W. P. White of New York, assistant to Mr. Largo, and J. W. Sentman, for 14 years a merchant in Philadelphia. H. P. B. Rook of Avon Park, is president of the company, and W. M. Rook also of Avon Park, is secretary-treasurer.
 "The formation of such a concern means much to a community," said C. A. Skipper yesterday. "We welcome it heartily and are confident that it will augment the activity we are going to see this fall and winter. Several members of the company are known to me personally, and I am looking forward with interest to their accomplishments."


