

HENDERSONS JOIN POSSE WITH OTHERS

Police Chief of Okeechobee City Among Number — On Way Now

The posse in pursuit of the four bandits who are believed to be surrounded on Key Largo, will be joined by five more fearless men early this morning. They are Bud and Randall Henderson, brothers of the two men who were killed by the bandits Saturday night; Chief of Police Collins, of Okeechobee City, and Idel Price, also of Lake Okeechobee, the owner of the boat Iola B, which the Rice boys are said to have stolen, and F. Richards, a friend of the Hendersons.

The two Henderson brothers went to Jupiter yesterday morning where they attended the funeral of their brothers and left Jupiter immediately after the funeral for the lower end of the county. They are in an auto and arrived in the city late last night.

Chief of Police Collins and Idel Price arrived from Okeechobee on the 11:30 train last night and are all ready to join the Hendersons in the search for the bandits.

Chief Collins had a narrow escape from being shot by one of the Rice boys. He has warrants for their arrest.
