**PARKING SPACE WANTED**

Miami Motor Club Secretary Would Have Regulations Revised.

Revised traffic regulations which will allow drivers of motor cars to park their automobiles on the main thoroughfares of Miami are being urged by W. S. Maxwell, secretary of the Miami Motor Club. Parking on both sides of Flagler street the entire length of the street, as well as

on at least one side of other downtown thoroughfares is being advocated.

Mr. Maxwell says that thousands of motorists, forced from their parking places in the Bayfront park, are adding to the congestion on Miami streets. He also said that the failure of the city to provide parking space in place of that formerly used on Bayfront park is forcing drivers to remain in the streams of downtown traffic from 30 minutes to an hour in attempting to find a garage or parking place for their automobiles.
