

GREAT DEALS IN BEEF CATTLE

MUCH MONEY CHANGES HANDS IN THIS STATE.

Some Details of a Big Industry, Which Is Attracting Attention.

One of the largest cattle deals ever made in Florida was successfully negotiated last week in Osceola County, says the Kissimmee Valley Gazette, E. O. Morgan and his son-in-law E. L. Lestey of Bassinger, sold to W. H. Towles five thousand head of stock cattle for the Cuban market. The price is not made public, but it is not far from \$50,000.

The cattle are now being gathered on the Kissimmee Valley range to be driven down to Punta Rassa and Mr. Towles is now in New York chartering a steamer to carry them to Cuba.

Messrs. Morgan and Lestey have also just sold seven hundred head of fine beef cattle from the Kissimmee River range to R. E. Whidden, of Arcadia, for the Cuban market. They are being delivered right away.

Allen Chandler of Fort Drum, has just sold to E. O. Morgan, of Bassinger, 941 head of stock cattle for \$8,000, for immediate delivery; and 459 head of future delivery for \$4,000, these last being \$8.50 per head. Total consideration, \$12,000.

A syndicate of well-known stock men and dealers have closed a contract to ship 800 head of first-class beef cattle to Tampa, for Cuba, at a first class price, probably \$15.

William Pitman of Thomasville, Ga., who was here last week, and is a substantial dealer, wants to sell 10,000 head of Georgia cattle for the Cuban market.

Another dealer, a Cuban, who was also here a few days ago on the range, wants 10,000 head of beef cattle for immediate delivery.

The deals above reported actually made in the past few days aggregate 8,000 head of stock and beef at a total price of not less than \$80,000 and probably \$100,000. This is not bad for one week and shows the importance of the Kissimmee stock market.

THE NEW THROUGH ROUTE

LATEST DEVELOPMENTS OF THE CONNECTING LINK.

The Work Now Going Forward to Connect Tampa and New York.

The combination of roads which now forms the Seaboard Air Line System proposes using the Pennsylvania Railroad for their Northern outlet. From Richmond Va., the system is to come to Quantico and Potomac and at that place, the tracks of the Pennsylvania Railroad will be met and used through the North. It is the plan of the syndicate carrying out the amalgamation of the different properties, to be ready to run trains from New York to Tampa, Fla., by Jan. 1, 1900.

Mr. Jno. Skelton Williams of Richmond, Va., who is the executive head of the system, was in Baltimore Saturday, says the Baltimore Sun, in conference with Mr. J. W. Addendort, of Addendort, Oliver and Co., who with the banking house of John L. Williams & Sons, of Richmond, formed the syndicate which is financing the new system. Mr. Williams left that night for Niagara Falls.

Rapid progress is being made in constructing the connecting links of the system. The line being built from Richmond Va., to Ridgeway N. C. to bring the Seaboard system to the Virginia capital will be finished in December. This is being built by the Richmond, Petersburg and Carolina Railroad Company, and this company will hold its annual meeting at Petersburg, Va., on next Saturday. Work has been commenced upon the steel bridge on which the road crosses the James river. Winston & Co. have the contract for the erection of the bridge. There is already on the ground forty-four cars of material, including steel and false stuff.

Between Cheraw and Columbia S. C., the gap is being rapidly filled in that will connect the Seaboard Air Line with the South Bound Railroad, another link in the new system and over which road Savannah is reached. Contracts have been awarded for a steel bridge to cross the Congaree river at Columbia and for another to cross the Wateree river between Columbia and Cheraw.

Work is going forward on the new terminals at Columbia. About thirty acres of land have been secured in that city, upon which to locate freight and passenger depots and yards. Liberal concessions were made by the City Council in consideration of these improvements.

At Savannah the terminals, embracing about a mile of water front will be completed in January.

In October the twenty miles of road from Meldrim to Savannah which will take into that city the Georgia and Alabama Railroad, another link of the system, over its own tracks will be completed. This work includes a steel draw bridge across the Savannah river, which will be finished at the same time. From Savannah to Florida points the system will use the Florida Central and Peninsular railroad, which is also part of the combination.

President Williams reports prosperous conditions as the result of a trip he had just finished over the Seaboard Air Line. General activity was noted especially in the lumber business, where the mills were behind in orders and prices had advanced for 30 to 40 per cent. The phosphate business of Florida, which is a big freight producer, he said, is fairly booming.

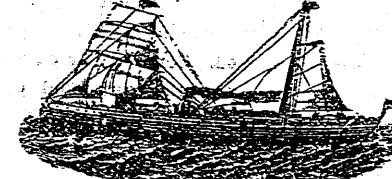

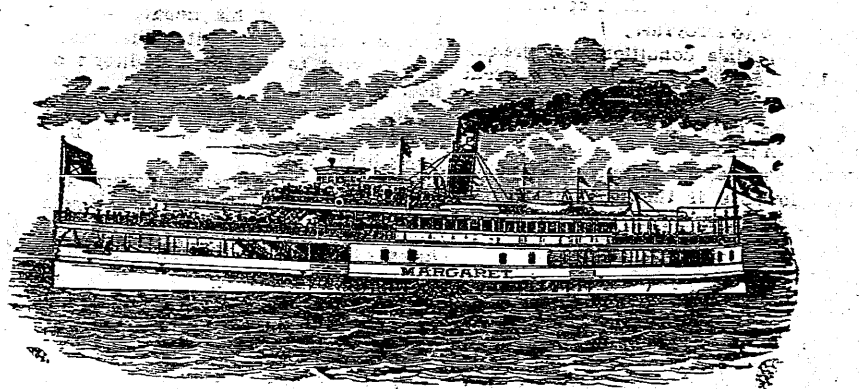
