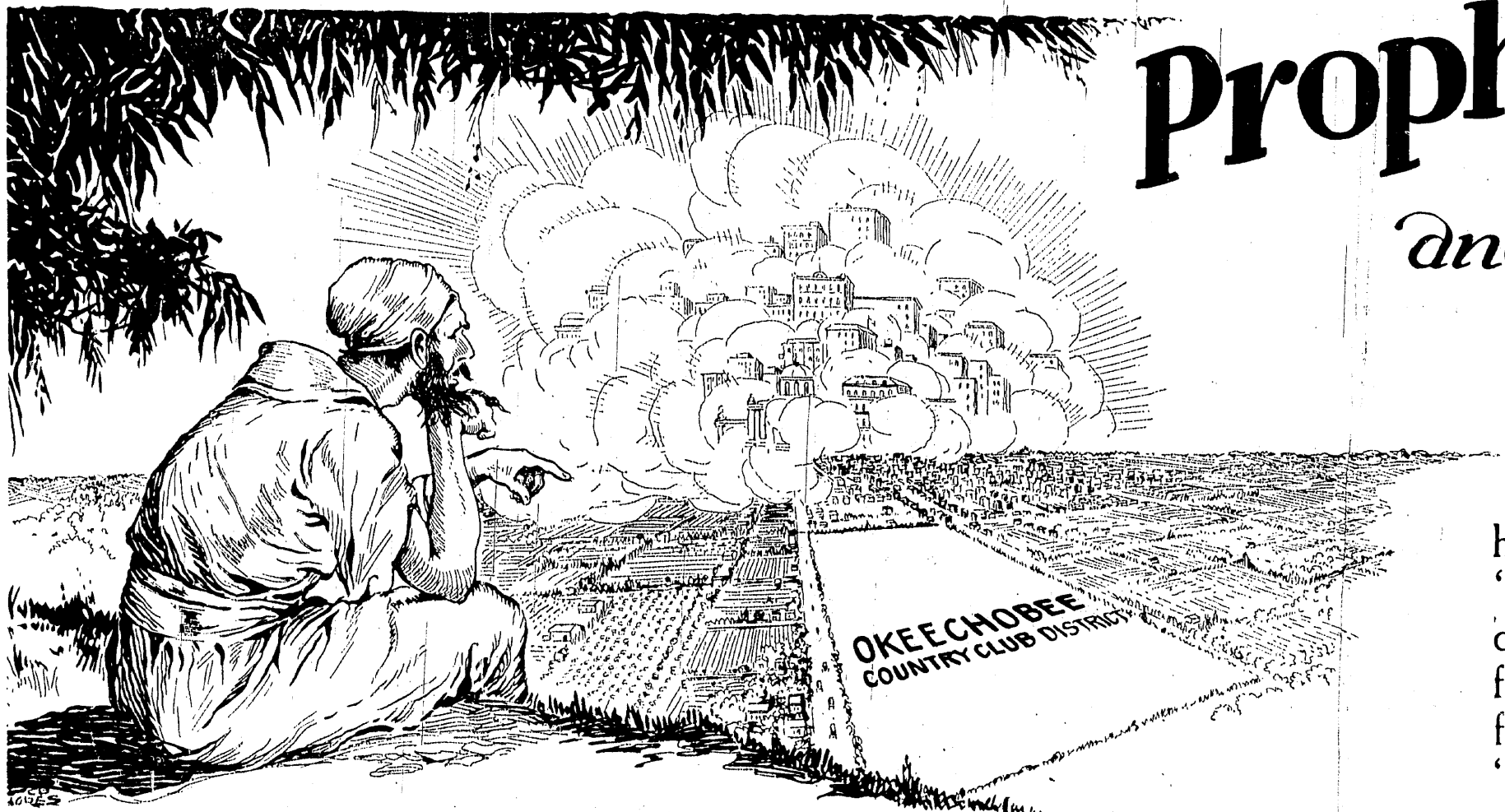


Prophets and Profits!
