

BARTOW MAYOR QUILTS

Leaders Resignation Effective On Election of Successors.

BARTOW, Fla., May 12.—It is B. Huffaker, who has been mayor since the inauguration of the commission form of government three and a half years ago and who was elected for a three-year term in December, 1923, has tendered his resignation, to take effect upon the election of his successor. His successor will be voted for at the special election called for June 9.

Mayor Commissioner Huffaker gave a reason for his resignation, "I have no business in connection with my law practice. When I stood for re-election a year and a half ago, I did so with the understanding that when the development program then being carried out, was completed, I would ask to be relieved," he said.

If there is anyone in view for the place made by Mr. Huffaker's resignation, it has not been made known. Joseph C. Boynton, president of the Bartow Rotary Club and also president of the chamber of commerce, and John D. Clark, one of the leading business men of the city, have been named as candidates for the two additional members of the city commission. The election has been called for June 9.

WILL WIDEN STREETS

Lakeland Has Ambitious Plans to Improve Thoroughfares.

LAKELAND, Fla., May 12.—With the widening of portions of Massachusetts avenue, south Florida and Tennessee, a program of street widening and development and boulevard building which will give Lakeland one of the finest cross-city and inter-lake systems of boulevards in the South has been started. It carried through in accordance with a program which has been tentatively outlined by C. C. Brown, city engineer.

At present Massachusetts is being widened to 40 feet from Cedar up to Orange, including Main, but the city proposes to widen it further to 51 feet from Cedar to Main. To do this, except in front of the city property, the work would have to be done under another contract and would necessitate the setting back of the building line in the same way as has been done on South Florida

avenue. The increased width would have to come as the result of property owners getting together and this purpose.
