### FLOODS IN GRADES FEAREMENCE TO SEMINOLE INDIANS

Reservation in Lee County Inundated

BIG AREA UNDER WATER

State Engineer Investigates—Township Lake Reported To Be Floodbound

Four that the last remaining large band of Seminole Indians is suffering extreme hardships by reason of the flooding of the 100,000 acre reservation in the southeastern part of Lee county was expressed by residents of that county who visited Tampa yesterday.

It was stated that the villages of Bare Beach, Little Clewiston, Oklawaha and other small places along the southwestern shore of Lake Okechobee were under water, and the level of the big lake is rising at the rate of an inch or two every twenty-four hours.

Rainfall at Port Myers for the month of September, according to figures compiled by the local observer here, totaled twenty-eight inches, while the rainfall for the first nine months of this year has been more than ten inches in excess of the average annual rainfall for that place, with three months of the year remaining.

Acquainted with conditions in Lee county state, however, that the unprecedented rains there have flooded the lands available for cultivation this year that otherwise would have been available in the spring of last October these lands, as well as several islands off the Lee county coast, are covered by the waters from the Gulf and the soil was so impregnated with salt that it was believed the land could not be used for several years. The tropical downpours of September, it was stated, have washed the salt out of the soil, and large areas will be available to winter vegetables as soon as the soil becomes sufficiently dry after the rains.

Telegraphic and telephone messages from points near Lake Okechobee last night were to the effect that the waters of the lake are higher than they have been for many years. Moore Haven reported that the Seminole river, flowing into Lake Okechobee at its northern end, was fully a mile wider from bank to bank than it was in the memory of the oldest inhabitants.

Engineers of the Florida Internal Improvement Commission are investigating conditions in Dade county and along the banks of the various canals and the shores of Lake Okechobee. It is expected that engineers from the U. S. bureau of engineering, war department, will be sent to the area to study the situation.

ASKING FOR BIDS ON TWO STATE HIGHWAYS

TALLAHASSEE, Oct. 4.—(Special.)—Bids have been given by the State Road Department that sealed proposals will be received by the department at the office of the state engineer at Tallahassee, Oct. 13, for constructing or improving a section of road No. 4, between the state road No. 1 and the county line.

The length of the road to be constructed or improved is approximately 11.6 miles and the estimated cost desired on the following type of paving:

1. Penetration Macadam on 8" Rock Base.

2. Asphalt with Binder Course on 8" Rock Base.

3. Plain Concrete Surface.

At the same time notice is being given to contractors that sealed proposals will be received by the board of county commissioners of Brevard county at Titusville until noon of Monday, Oct. 9, for the construction of a road No. 4, one section being between Snarps and Titusville, approximately 2.25 miles and the other section between Bonaventure and Eau Gallie, approximately 7.0 miles. All sealed proposals are desired on the following classes of paving 18 feet wide:

1. Penetration Macadam on 8" Rock Base.

WILL DISCUSS APPORTIONMENT AMENDMENT

Other Speakers To Be Heard On Two More Constitutional Changes

When the editors of South Florida convene at Lakeland October 13 and 14, Gov. Cary A. Hardee will appear on the program as a speaker, his subject being the apportionment, according to announcement Wednesday by Frank Kay Anderson, of Tampa, secretary of the association.

In response to an invitation recently addressed to the governor by Mr. Anderson, in behalf of the association, Governor Hardee expressed himself as glad of the opportunity to come before the South Florida editors and explain his views of the re-apportionment amendment to be voted on in the November general election.

In addition to the re-apportionment question, which will have the fullest discussion possible, the amendment dealing with broader powers for the legislature in creation of additional judgeships without establishing additional districts will be taken up. Circuit Judge Armistead Brown, of Miami, president of the Florida Bar Association, will lead the discussion on this subject, while Prof. David M. Cook, of Tampa, will start the discussion of the amendment proposing an increase of three mills in the maximum levy for school purposes.

W. G. Broderick, of Tampa, president of the South Florida Bar Association, and G. Z. Phillips, of Jacksonville, assistant passenger agent of the Seaboard Air Line Railway, will be on the program for addresses. Others are also expected to speak.

Because of the importance of the subjects to be discussed and the acceptance of the invitation to speak, stressed his desire that there be a full attendance on the part of the scribes.
