
CITY COUNCIL PRESIDENT.—H. H. De Yarman, Okeechobee council president, is also manager of the Standard Oil Company there.



OKEECHOBEE MERCHANT.—Is one of Abe Freedman's activities. He is a large property owner and realty dealer.




MAYOR CONELY.—T. W. Conely is mayor of Okeechobee, and county attorney, and practices law.







HEAD OF JUPITER INLET WORK,—Earl Menges of Lake Worth is a civil engineer in charge of the work at Jupiter Inlet.




FORMER POSTMASTER.—O. J. Price resigned as postmaster of Okeechobee to enter the real estate business.


